## RE: Peripatetic Music Lessons for Autumn Term 2017/2018 (Sept –Dec 2017) Music students going into Year 12

Students who are undertaking an A-Level in Music are eligible for one free instrumental lesson per week for 34 weeks, with a tutor provided by Southend Music Services. These lessons last for a duration of 15 minutes and take place either during the school lunch hour (1.00pm-2.00pm) or after school (3.30pm-4.30pm)

Currently within the school, private instrumental music tuition is offered on the following musical instruments: violin, viola, guitar (acoustic, bass and electric), clarinet, saxophone, flute, brass, drum, piano, keyboard and vocal. These tuition slots are limited by availability.

If you would like for your son/daughter to have these instrumental lessons, a **deposit of £90.00 is required**. This amount will be fully refunded to you at the end of the A-Level provided that all lessons have been attended by your son/daughter, or that notice, in keeping with the terms and conditions, has been provided. If your son/daughter has received these free lessons as part of their GCSE provision, any levy/deposit paid can be carried forward into this year meaning no further amounts are due.

Please complete the attached document to inform us of your lesson requirements; you will then be emailed directly to confirm any lessons for next term and to request payment of the deposit via Wisepay (if necessary). Please note, failure to return your document by the date shown could mean that your son/daughter misses the opportunity to reserve a slot.

If you would like for your son/daughter to have a double lesson, or an additional lesson on a different instrument, the cost of this extra lesson will be borne by you. <u>Each lesson costs £7.50</u>, which means an annual course of 34 <u>lessons totals £255.00</u>. This is broken down into the following termly charges: £90.00 for the Autumn term, £90.00 for the Spring term and £75.00 for the Summer Term. All amounts are payable in advance of the start of the new term.

The procedure for booking these 'extra' lessons is through Wisepay; parents will need to log onto Wisepay to select and pay for their desired instrument and time slot for the Autumn term.

Parents of GCSE and A-Level Music students are given early access to Wisepay to allow them to book double slots, if desired, from Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> June. However Wisepay will open to all other parents of students currently having lessons on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June.
