INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

1. It is expected that anyone applying to join the Sixth Form will be aware of the nature of the AS and A Level subjects desired, the entry requirements and the general educational approach of the school – particularly within the Sixth Form. All this information is contained in the Sixth Form Handbook which is issued to everyone who attends the prospective Year 12 Open Evening. Copies of the Handbook are available on request from the school.
2. The closing date for applications is the **end of December 2011**.
3. On receipt of applications a request will be made to your present school to provide us with your predicted GCSE grades.
 - Offers will be made during January-February 2012, according (a) to the estimated availability of places in the year group and (b) to the applicant's position in an order of merit (calculated from schools' predicted grades for GCSE).
 - The published minimum entry criterion of 10 points at GCSE is a qualifying base threshold only. It does not confer automatic right of admission. Numbers of applicants normally exceed the school's capacity to admit, for which reason we will establish your place an order of merit based upon your present school's predicted GCSE grades. (N.B. While we expect the majority of your grades to be in GCSEs, if your school offers only alternative courses in occasional subjects, these will be weighed and considered - provided GCSEs are dominant overall. However, except in the case of 'new' subjects it is unlikely that we would be able to offer you a place on an AS course that you have not studied to GCSE.)
 - Where predicted grades do not suggest suitability for our Sixth Form, or where these fall short of a level that will lead to admission, applicants will be notified at once.
 - Very occasionally, applicants will be asked to come into school if there is need for discussion about the application in terms of grades, subject choices, etc. (NB In accordance with statutory practice, we do not seek references and there is no formal admission interview.)
4. Applicants receiving offers will be expected to confirm acceptance or otherwise by a specified date. Changes to subject choices will be possible after confirmation only if there are vacancies in subject groups. N.B. No assumption should be made that such late changes will be possible
5. All those holding offers for whom this school is first choice will be asked to attend the **Sixth Form Induction Programme on 2 July - 4 July 2012 inclusive**.
6. Applicants with offers are asked to inform the school of their grades on the day of publication and to submit a photocopy of the results to the School Office *within two working days*.
