INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

1. It is expected that anyone applying to join the Sixth Form will be aware of the nature of the AS and A Level subjects desired, the entry requirements and the general educational approach of the school – particularly within the Sixth Form. All this information is contained in the Sixth Form Handbook which is issued to everyone who attends the prospective Year 12 Open Evening. Copies of the Handbook are available on request from the school.
2. The closing date for applications is the **end of December 2009**.
3. On receipt of applications a reference will be requested from your present school, to include estimates of GCSE grades.
 - Offers will be made during January-February 2010, according (a) to the estimated availability of places in the year group and (b) to the applicant's position in an order of merit (calculated from schools' estimated grades for GCSE).
 - Where estimated grades do not suggest suitability for our Sixth Form, applicants will be notified at once.
 - Some applicants will be asked to come into school if there is need for discussion about the application in terms of grades, subject choices, etc. (NB There is no formal admission interview.)
4. Applicants receiving offers will be expected to confirm acceptance or otherwise by a specified date. Changes to subject choices will be possible after confirmation only if there are vacancies in subject groups.
5. All those holding offers for whom this school is first choice will be asked to attend the **Sixth Form Induction Programme on 28 June - 30 June 2010** inclusive.
6. Applicants with offers are asked to inform the school of their grades on the day of publication and to submit a photocopy of the results to the School Office *within two working days*.
