Dear Parents,

Thank you for signing your son up to Summer School for the week of 9-13<sup>th</sup> August. I can now confirm the arrangements for the week.

Please note that we will have two different start times during the week to enable us to safely accommodate results days for our Year 11 and 13 students. As you will see below, this means that on Monday, Wednesday and Friday the start time will be 8.45am, but on Tuesday and Thursday the start time will be 8.00am. **It will not be possible to arrive any later than 8.00am on Tuesday or Thursday because of arrangements made for our results day.** The finish time will remain the same each day: 2.15pm.

Although many of the Covid-19 restrictions will have been lifted by August, it is still important to ensure that everyone stays safe, and so we would ask that your son takes a lateral flow test on the Wednesday and Sunday before Summer School, and that you follow the guidelines that we set for induction day, as below:

- As a parent/guardian dropping off and picking up your son, please wear a mask at all times (unless medically exempt).
- Please drop off your son at the main gates on Prittlewell Chase no earlier than 8.30am and no later than 8.45am on Monday, Wednesday and Friday, and no later than 7.45 and not later than 8am on Tuesday and Thursday.
- You must leave the area immediately after dropping off your son. This is to avoid creating unnecessary gatherings.
- No parking is allowed on site. There is plenty of parking in surrounding streets – please allow time to find a parking space which is legal and mindful of our neighbours.
- Please collect your son from the school gate no earlier than 2.15pm and no later than 2.30pm.



Your son will be doing activities in a variety of subjects such as Maths, English, Politics, Drama, History and PE over the five days. Please ensure that your son wears comfortable clothing and brings a change of clothes suitable for sport for both indoor and outdoor activities; he will also need a pencil case with writing equipment and coloured pens or pencils. All sports equipment will be provided by the school.

There will be a short break in the morning each day for refreshments and 45 minutes for lunch. A snack for the morning break and lunch will be provided free of charge. We will be providing information about food shortly, along with a menu, and will be asking you to choose your son's food for each day so that we can place the order.

Your son should bring a water bottle and sun protection if it is a hot day (sun cream and a hat would be advisable).

On the final day, there will be an optional football tournament in the afternoon where the boys will be able to compete in three trophy tournaments (there will be other activities available for those who do not wish to take part in the football tournament).
