## Thank you: Covid home-testing

We know how much everyone in the school community is hoping for minimal disruption to learning this term. The school featured on BBC Look East last Thursday, the first day of term, with our students talking about how good it is to be 'back to normal' but also speaking honestly about the importance of continuing with regular home-testing to screen for Covid. ## School Closure: 11+ (Friday 17<sup>th</sup> pm only <u>and</u> Monday 20<sup>th</sup> all day)

Following the directives of the Department for Education, in Covid-19 guidance, we are required to manage this year's 11+ examination with reduced numbers in each classroom and limited social mixing. We are following the same model of provision as last year.

School will be closed to pupils from 1pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> September, to allow time for cleaning and set-up prior to the traditional 11+ sitting on the Saturday. There will be no facility for pupils to remain on site into the afternoon: please arrange homeward journeys accordingly.

School will remain closed to pupils on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> September, all day, for a second 11+ sitting followed by cleaning and clear-up.
