Our dedicated cake sale and 'wear yellow' day last Friday raised over £1400. This event was organised by our Sixth Form students to support the charity Young Minds, at a time when many in our community are deeply conscious of the impact on friends and family of mental health challenges. ## Non-uniform day: charity fund-raising

In addition to the direct education of young people and adults, SRtRC produces educational resources, to challenge misconceptions, stereotypes and negative attitudes in society.

### Thank you: Covid home-testing

May I repeat our appreciation for your support of the home-testing programme for all students. So far, this term, positive LFTs have helped to identify a small but significant number of students who have then attended for a PCR: in doing so, we are able to keep the levels of transmission within school to a minimum. Please continue to ensure regular home-testing across the half-term holiday – home testing kits are available at school or from your local pharmacy.

#### **Covid Vaccinations: update**

Schools have been asked to make their premises available for the NHS school immunisation service to administer Covid vaccinations for those aged 12-15. The school is *still* awaiting confirmation of a date when this will happen at SHSB, although we understand this will now be after half-term. Schools are being visited in turn. The NHS will, in due course, be providing literature to explain the vaccination offer and the process of parental consent. As with all vaccinations given on the school site by the NHS, all decisions regarding immunisation will be made by qualified NHS personnel.

We understand that the delay is simply a result of logistics and the 'delivery capacity' of the School Immunisation Service. To allow the immunisation team to focus on the Covid vaccinations, we have been advised that the scheduled flu vaccinations (due for next week) have been postponed, with no rescheduled date at this time.

We will, of course, keep you advised as new information is provided.
