"How can you help?"

- Time the journey to school and make sure you do the journey with him before he starts in September
 - ✓ Get a loud alarm clock for him!
 - ✓ Supply all the uniform he needs
 - ✓ Agree and establish routine (eg Homework)
 - ✓ Get a decent bag to carry and protect his books
 - ✓ Remind him to pack his bags the night before

✓ Have a system at home for his work

- Establish good habits of work and independence help and praise
 - ✓ Show an interest in his school work and homework
 ✓ (Go4Schools and Satchel one)
- Encourage him to use his School Diary and monitor all he does
 - Remember that it's worth the effort now to get things right at the start
