RE: Year 13 Biology students – Residential Fieldwork Visit to Juniper Hall, 22nd November – 24th November 2023 – LIMITED SPACES AVAILABLE

Further to our previous letter in May, this is the final opportunity for year 13 Students studying biology to secure a place on the Ecology Field Trip at the FSC Field Studies Centre at Juniper Hall in Dorking.

The 3-day residential course offers a fantastic opportunity for students to undertake ecological investigations in a variety of inspiring habitats and complete relevant required practicals. Students will investigate biodiversity within an ecosystem, population dynamics and ecosystem management. They will develop their practical skills, use of apparatus and techniques, and deepen their understanding of the ecological syllabus content and synoptic links through first-hand experience. These skills and content are assessed in the AQA A Level Biology exams students will sit in May/June 2024. It is for this reason your child's attendance, although not compulsory, is strongly encouraged.

The **total cost of this visit is expected to be £220.00**, this includes transport and food whilst at the centre (hot breakfast and evening meals and a packed lunch). *The exact figure may vary slightly. We will communicate any variance with this value to you once all numbers have been provided to the Tour Provider and they have been able to confirm the final figure*. This will be collected in instalments as per the schedule shown below:

We have secured 45 places on this trip, there are now only limited spaces available. At this late stage the full amount of £220.00 will need to be paid no later than Tuesday 26 September 2023.

Please be aware that, once this booking is confirmed, the company's cancellation policy applies. Should your child wish to withdraw from the trip at any stage going forward, this policy will dictate the level of refund possible.
