Dear Parents and Carers,

Following their successful participation at our school's Model United Nations conference in September, your son/daughter has been selected to attend the Brentwood Model United Nations at the Brentwood School on **Sunday 19th and Monday 20th November**. This is an excellent event where students play the role of delegates to the United Nations and simulate UN committees.

On both days, your son/daughter will need to **EITHER** arrive at Brentwood Rail Station at 8.30am, where our staff will register them and accommodate them on the short journey to Brentwood School **OR** they will need to arrive directly at the Brentwood School at 9.00am where they will meet us to register.

Our staff will supervise the conference all day, alongside the Brentwood School staff. Lunch will be provided by The Brentwood School on both days. The event is formal, so we advise them to wear office wear on both days.

The event will finish at approximately 4.30pm on both days. Your son/daughter will then **EITHER** be dismissed from the Brentwood School at 4.30pm, where they are free to make their own way home **OR** our staff can accommodate them back to Brentwood Rail Station, where they will be dismissed (approximately 5pm).

We are offering these options because we understand it may not be possible to take your child to Brentwood on a weekday and it was not cost effective to run a coach across two days. Students will be issued with a school mobile phone number to contact if there are any problems.

The cost of the trip is £30, which covers their lunch and resources. This amount is payable via WisePay - you will find it under the "Trips and Visits" section. We request that this amount is paid by **Friday 13th October**. Should you have any difficulties in accessing your account, or any concerns about making the payment due, please contact [mcw@shsb.org.uk](mailto:mcw@shsb.org.uk) at your earliest convenience.

In order for your child to attend this visit you must also complete the school's offsite visit form. Please indicate on the form for **both days**, where your son/daughter will be traveling from. The form is available via the hyperlink below and must be completed no later than **Friday 13th October**.
