Dear Students and Parents

16-19 Bursary Fund for academic year 2023-2024

If you are aged between 16 and 19 years (i.e. in Years 12 or 13) and think your family might struggle to support you through full-time education, you may qualify to receive a bursary. The bursary can be used to pay for school uniform, meals, books, educational visits, transport and any other course-related costs needed to help a young person stay in education. Travel expenses for up to three Higher Education visits can be supported for the student prior to approval from the Head of Sixth Form. Receipts for any claim will be required as evidence.

If you applied in 2022 and were granted a bursary award, you will need to reapply for this academic year.

There are two levels of bursary payments (please refer to our 16-19 Bursary Policy):

- 1. Vulnerable student bursaries
- 2. Discretionary bursaries

The Government has delegated a calculated sum of money to each school and tasked us with awarding bursaries to our students. With the exception of students who fall into Category 1 above, the level of bursary available will be dependent upon the number of applications approved and the amount of funding allocated to the school. The fund will be divided equally amongst all eligible students.

At SHSB it has been decided that, if in the current economic climate, a family's personal circumstances have dipped to a critical level, the student will be welcome to apply for a bursary. Admittance to the scheme will then be at the school's discretion. (N.B. The family income threshold for bursary consideration currently stands at £27,500 p.a.).

The school will decide when bursaries are paid and will set conditions that students must meet to continue to receive it. These will link to behaviour, attendance, punctuality and quality of work and adherence to the sixth form code of conduct. All parents and students who successfully apply will be asked to sign a contract (please refer to Bursary Fund Policy).
