Dear Parents and Carers

Re: Year 12 Politics Students - New York and Washington DC Trip 17th - 22nd February 2025

Following our successful trip in February 2023 to New York and Washington DC, I am pleased to share with you that we are proposing to run a revised and improved version of the trip in February 2025. There has already been considerable interest from the current year 12 Politics students who have been given first priority to attend. However, before we open the trip up more widely to other students in year 12 we wanted to give any students currently in year 11 who will be studying A Level Politics next year the opportunity to sign up.

The trip includes visits to New York and Washington DC; two American cities which are home to some of the world's most influential institutions. The trip provides fantastic opportunities that complement a number of A Level courses, not only Politics, but also Geography, Economics, Business, History, Art, Drama and so many more. A number of our visits will have a particular focus on global politics and globalisation, however, there will also be opportunities for sight-seeing, shopping and the opportunity to watch a show on Broadway to make the most of our visit.

The price of the trip will depend considerably on the price of flights. We are currently working on a projected cost of approx. £2225 per student. This includes flights from London to New York, and a return flight from Washington to London, airport transfers, accommodation in New York and Washington DC, transport between New York and Washington DC, two meals a day (breakfast and dinner), pre-booked visits and tours, a Broadway show and numerous site-seeing opportunities. Whilst elements of the itinerary cannot be guaranteed at this stage due to limits to the extent bookings can be made in advance, the intention is for the itinerary to include visits to the 9/11 memorial and museum, Liberty Island, the United Nations, a walking tour and workshop around the financial district, a walking tour round DC, the White House visitor centre and the National Museum of African American History and Culture.

The only costs which are not included are the application for an ESTA (approx. £18) or a Visa which needs to be done by the individual travelling (or their parent/guardian), money for lunch each day on the trip and any spending money for snacks, souvenirs, etc.

Due to the expected popularity of this trip, places will be allocated on a 'first-come, first served' basis in terms of deposits paid. A non-refundable deposit payment of £200.00 is required to secure a place for your child. In order to ensure fairness on this occasion, all deposits must be paid via WisePay. The places remaining on Monday will be made available for students in year 11 who have chosen Politics as one of their subjects next year. Wisepay will be opened for payments at 1.00pm on Monday 18th December. Any remaining places will be opened to additional students once we return to school in January 2024. Please ensure that you have access











to WisePay in advance of this date, if you have any difficulties, please contact Mrs Wightman in the Finance Office at your earliest opportunity on MCW@shsb.org.uk.

When/if these places are gone, the following form should be completed to put their names onto a waiting list. We will use this to assign any additional spaces, or contact students if places become available at a later date. The waiting list form can be found here and will open when tickets are released on Wisepay - https://forms.office.com/e/M1eyGkrGcZ

The payment schedule including exact dates of the deadlines will be communicated upon confirmation of your child's place on the trip. However, as an indication, the expectation is that the payment schedule will be something along the lines of the table below. The final payment is subject to change as it will depend on any changes to flight costs that are passed on by the tour company.
