Each assessment in Years 7 to 9 contributes to an **overall judgement of progress** in each subject, which we summarize as being either **Developing**, **Assured**, **Thriving** or **Mastering**:

DEVELOPING

Moving forward in learning, but not yet at the standard we would expect in this subject

~0-10th percentile

ASSURED

Demonstrating confident learning, in line with our school expected standards

~10th -70th percentile

THRIVING

Comfortably performing above our school expected standard

~70th-90th percentile

MASTERING

Engaged in learning far above the school expected standards

~90th-100th percentile




Year 9 Curriculum (2024/25)

- Taster lessons for Drama (Early January 2024) All pupils will experience a typical Drama session lasting no longer than 1 hour.
- IAR 2 to parents (Middle of January 2024).
- Virtual Parents evening (22nd of January 2024)

9th of February 2024 – Final Options forms returned to school.
