What you need to bring

- Small cabin bag or rucksack
 - 45 x 36 x 20 cm maximum
 - up to 15kg
- Liquids 100ml max
- Passport
- Medication
- Towel and toiletries
- Change of clothes
- Waterproof jacket
- Comfortable footwear
- Travel plug for charging devices
- Spending money – Swiss Francs (or Euros- allow £20 per day for meals and drinks)

Safeguarding

- You will each be assigned a member of staff to check in with at various times during the day for a head count. Make sure that that member of staff knows where you at all times.
- While out and about in Geneva, always make sure you are in a group of at least 3 people. Never leave anyone on their own.
- You will be given the emergency contact number for a member of staff which can be used at any time, for example if you become separated from your group.
- Make sure you have provided staff with your mobile number which will only be used in emergencies
- You must return to the hostel by 10:00 pm and be in your room at 10:15pm. Boys must not go into the girls' room and vice versa.
- During your free time, you can use your public transport ticket to explore Geneva, but only use the water taxi with a member of staff present.

Student behaviour and expectations

- We always expect exemplary behaviour from all students
 - No alcohol, vapes or drugs are to be brought, purchased or consumed on the trip, regardless of age.
This is a school trip and school rules apply as normal.
 - Parents will be contacted by staff if there is a breach of trust and the rules. In serious cases the headmaster will be informed, and a student may be removed from the trip at parents' expense.
- Students are to follow all of the rules set out by the Youth Hostel and places visited
- Students are to follow all instructions given by the Youth Hostel staff, staff during visits and teachers (loco parentis) supervising the trip.
- Students must be in their rooms by 10:15pm ready for staff checks at 10:30pm and lights out by 11:00pm
- All personal belongings brought on the trip are the responsibility of the student
 - Students are advised not to bring valuable items
