Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to invite you to the Spring Term Concert on the evening of **Wednesday, 27th March at 7.30pm.**

This evening promises a diverse range of quality musical performances. Our established groups have been rehearsing all term for these performances and, as ever, new initiatives and ensembles will be on display.

You may wish to establish with your child whether or not they belong to any of the groups which are performing on the evening.

Tickets cost £5.00. After covering the costs involved in the evening, proceeds from ticket sales go to fund the extracurricular work of the music department.

Tickets will be available to purchase on WisePay from Wednesday 28 February at 8:30am, under 'Seat and Event Bookings' and individual seats can be selected. It is easier to book using the desktop version of WisePay. **Please be patient when selecting 'View Details', do not refresh or reload the page, it may take a while for the hall seating plan to load.**

Please note that tickets are **initially limited to 4 per family in total** and will be sold on a first-come first-served basis. **Please do not purchase more than 4 in total** – this should allow parents of all performers to obtain tickets.

Please do not leave single seats when choosing seats for a family booking, this will ensure as many families as possible are able to sit together.

Your confirmation e-mail is your ticket, please ensure you are able to display it on your mobile or have a printed copy on arrival. Tickets are non-refundable. Refunds will only be made if the event is cancelled or rescheduled.

We anticipate a big demand for tickets, so it is important to make your purchases as a matter of urgency, and **by Wednesday 20th March at the latest**. Any spare tickets will be made available to parents after this date, until midday on the date of the performance, again on a first-come first-served basis).
