## Re: International Competition for Young Debaters – Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2024

I am pleased to inform you that your child has been selected to represent SHSB in the International Competition for Young Debaters on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> March. It will take place at LSE, from 09:00 until 17:30.

This is the first time we have entered this competition, however, we regularly participate in the Oxford and Cambridge Schools Competitions in which we normally perform very well. The competitions are always an enjoyable experience with an opportunity to debate against some of the strongest secondary level debaters in the country.

I am proposing that Mr Ingoldby and I will meet the team at Fenchurch Street (the end of the concourse with the ticket office) at 08:45.
