### **Options:**

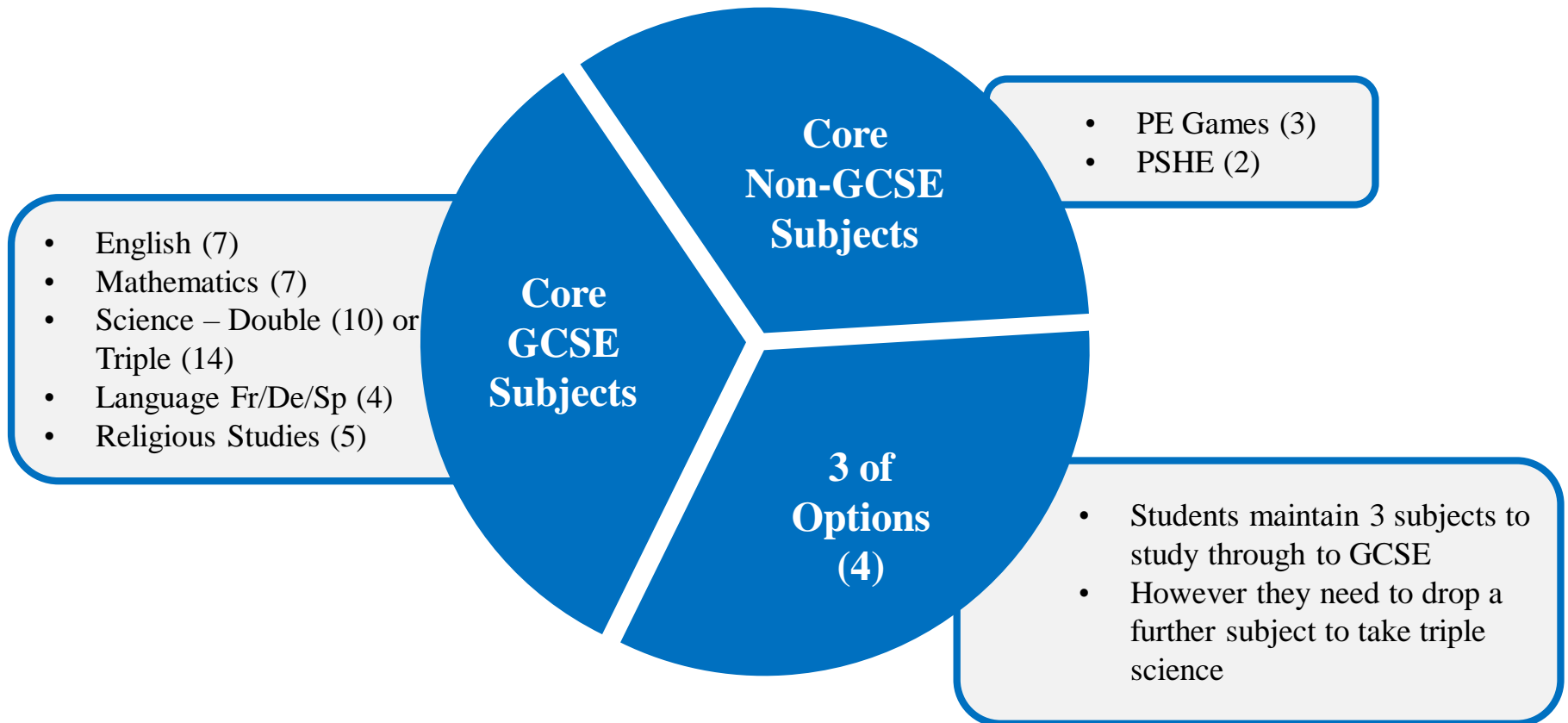

## You should note the following...

- 1. Courses will only run if there are sufficient numbers;**
- 2. In some cases, capacity in certain subjects is limited;**
- 3. We recommend students choose Geography or History;**
- 4. You are strongly advised to choose at least one of the following: Art, Drama, Music, DT or PE. However, we advise that students do no more than three.**
