The Geography department at SHSB considers the following criteria to be important in defining what is meant by being More Able and Talented in Geography.

- Excellent performance relative to peer group as identified through the school assessment system, classwork, projects and tests.
- Skilful processing of information – able to grasp new concepts with ease.
- Higher order thinking – able to respond well to class questioning and exam questions. e.g. strong longer response answers.
- Highly efficient memory and application of knowledge to solving business problems e.g. which solution should a business use to improve its profitability.
- Very curious about events and how things work as demonstrated through their background knowledge of the subject
- Strong interest in current affairs, use of relevant examples in class work
- Good ability to ask appropriate questions about topics.
- Good communicator – as demonstrated in questions and answer sessions, discussion and presentation work.
- Works well independently and good self-motivator.
- Strong numerical skills as illustrated by fieldwork and skills elements.
