The event starts earlier on the Monday, and therefore they will meet at Felsted at 9.00am. There will be no staff from Southend High School for Boys attending but the event is fully supervised by teaching staff at Felsted School. Please be advised that you are responsible for arranging transport to and from the venue for your child. In previous years students have made their own way to Braintree and shared taxi costs from there. Lunch will be provided by Felsted School on both days and there is a coffee shop on site if you wish to use it. The event is formal, so we advise students to wear office wear on both days.

The event will finish at 4.00pm on both days. However, on the Sunday there is a reception which will be held until 4.45pm, if they wish to stay for refreshments and to meet students from other schools.
