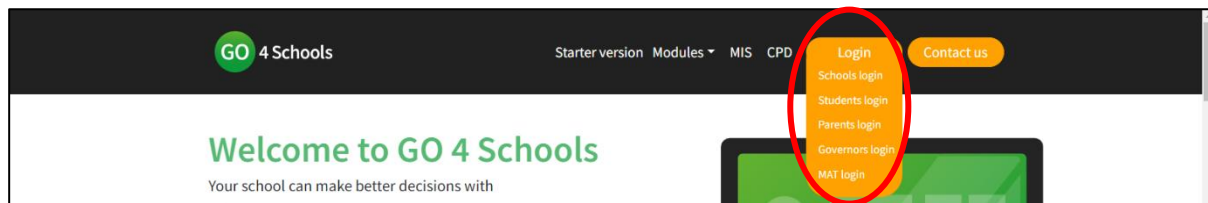

Dear Parents,

The school uses a data information management system called Go4Schools. This provides parents with online access to student progress reports that contain details of their child's current grades, progress, behaviour, rewards and attendance.

You will need to make an initial login to Go4Schools and you can do this by going to the Go4Schools site at <https://www.go4schools.com/> and clicking the 'parents login' option (under 'login' at the top of the page).



This will take you to a registration page, where you will need to click on 'First-time User?'; please then follow the prompts.

The email address you enter *must* match the email address which you have provided to the school for parental contact. If you have updated your email address or are unsure which email address the school holds for you, please contact us as soon as possible on enquiries@shsb.org.uk

You will not actually be sent a password – you will be taken to a page where you will need to **create your own password** and then confirm by re-entering. You will then be taken back to the 'welcome' page where you should enter your email address and your newly-created password.

When you have completed your first log-in, you will be in a position to view the on-line reports. Please see the guidance below on how to see your child's report.

Please note, there will be periods where you will not be able to see any data until we have made it available.

Instructions for parents on how to view their child's progress:

Once logged in to Go4Schools, you will see the screen below as a 'homepage' – on the left-hand side, click on 'progress' (highlighted in red below):

Once you have clicked on 'progress' you will see the progress summary page:



From here, you can view your child's grades at a glance, as well as scroll to click on individual subjects to find more detailed information on their progress.

The Go4Schools Mobile App

If you own a phone that supports the application, then you can download the Go4Schools App. This gives parents live data on attendance, progress and behaviour. The app is available to download from both the apple (iPhone) and google play (android) stores. There is also a link to download the app from the website's homepage when you log-in.
