Re: A Level Drama Visit to East 15 Acting School, Southend

As part of our A Level Drama course, we are delighted to offer students the opportunity to visit **East 15 Acting School** in Southend for a day of workshops and experiences led by industry professionals. This visit will take place on **Thursday 20th November** and is completely free of charge.

East 15 is one of the UK's leading drama schools, offering a wide range of specialist performance and technical theatre training. The day will give students valuable insight into conservatoire-style training, as well as the chance to take part in practical workshops exploring acting, movement, and stage combat. They will also have the opportunity to meet current students and learn more about the pathways available in higher-level performance training and see a dress rehearsal of their latest performance at the Clifftown theatre with a Q&A afterwards.

Students will meet me at the university on the corner of Elmer Approach and Luker Road (near café Nero on the high street, **SS1 1LW**) at **9:45am**. They will be released from the Clifftown Theatre nearby at approximately 5pm to make their own way home. They will need to bring a packed lunch, water, and wear comfortable clothing suitable for physical workshops (no jeans, skirts, or open-toed shoes, please).
