Dear Parents and Carers,

This letter contains information regarding GCSE Results Day 2026, so please read this carefully with your son to ensure the day runs smoothly.

### GCSE Results Day: 20<sup>th</sup> August 2026 – Arrive from 8:30am

We encourage all students to come and collect their results in person between 8.30am and 11.00am in our Main Hall. We ask that **only** students enter the building to collect results to help with congestion. Please arrive through the front gate on Prittlewell Chase and follow the signage. Parking will be available on our playground.

### Accepting a Place in the Sixth Form

Should your son meet the entry requirements of 52 points, he can accept his place in the Sixth Form using the paper form within his results pack. The completed form should be handed to Mr Sweeting, who will be his new Year Leader, in the school foyer before he leaves school. ***This process must happen by 12pm.*** Alternatively, if your son is leaving SHSB, we need to know where he will be studying so his file can be forwarded.

### Available Support on the Day

Should your son need some support after receiving his results, we will have staff available, including our Careers Adviser, within the Pavilion to discuss possible options. We will also have Mrs McNish, our exams officer, available on the day should he wish to discuss his results or post results services. There is a one-day time limit on applications for priority services such as reviews, so all paperwork and payable fees are needed promptly (cash or cheque only). There will be more information on these within the results pack.

### If Your Son is Unable to Attend on the Day

We strongly encourage students to come in person, but if this is not possible, there are two options available.

1. Your son can nominate someone to collect his results using the attached form 'External Examinations Results Collection Request'. This form must be completed and returned to the Main Office via [enquiries@shsb.org.uk](mailto:enquiries@shsb.org.uk) before results day. Please also note that the nominee will need to bring photographic ID on the day.



2. Grades will be released on the DfE Education Record app and on Go4Schools on student accounts only but not until later in the day, at 11.00am. Once these results are received, an email confirmation can be sent to [sixthformadmissions@shsb.org.uk](mailto:sixthformadmissions@shsb.org.uk) accepting your son's Sixth Form place. If you are not accepting the place, we also ask that you confirm this. ***This email must contain your son's full name and be sent by 12pm at the latest.***

We look forward to seeing your son to collect his results on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August.
