SCHOOL-STUDENT CONTRACT

This Contract ensures that each individual who joins the Sixth Form at Southend High School for Boys is fully aware of the school's undertakings to its students and of the expectations the school has of its students.

A. THE SCHOOL WILL:

- i support its students and take an interest in each person as an individual;
- ii offer guidance and direction;
- iii assist students in the acquisition of appropriate study skills;
- iv endeavour to ensure the appropriate delivery of the Sixth Form curriculum in a healthy and safe working environment;
- v conduct personal reviews (subject and tutorial) to chart progress, address specific needs and set mutually agreed targets;
- vi provide a comprehensive programme of careers guidance, including help with applications and interviews;
- vii administer the UCAS process for entry to Higher Education and provide references both for university and career entry;
- viii ensure access to support from outside agencies (e.g. educational welfare, school nurse) as required;
- ix keep parents informed of progress via parents evenings, information evenings, written reports and (where required) individual contact.

B. THE STUDENT WILL:

- i acknowledge his/her responsibility as a senior student and role model within the wider school community by setting an example of good conduct and high personal standards, and by respecting the school's rules and regulations;
- ii treat staff and fellow students with courtesy and respect;
- iii attend school regularly and punctually, work hard, show commitment and submit work on time;
- iv strike a sensible balance between the demands of academic work, extra-curricular activities and life outside school, ensuring school-based academic commitments always have priority;
- v accept responsibility for individual learning and focus his/her efforts on successful study;
- vi actively seek opportunities to contribute to the school's extra-curricular life;
- vii maintain a constructive attitude to study by (a) using all possible resources to broaden subject knowledge, (b) discussing problems with teachers and (c) seeking guidance as necessary;
- viii undertake to catch up on work missed through absence.
